We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of K.M. Sugar Mills Ltd. (the Company) for the quarter ended and nine months period ended 31s December, 2017 being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. Attention is drawn to the fact that the figures for the corresponding quarter ended 31" December, 2016 including the reconciliation of profit under Ind AS of the corresponding period with profit reported under previous GAAP, as reported in these financial results have been approved by company's Board of Directors but have not been subjected to review.

Attention is drawn to the fact that the figures for the quarter ended 31st December, 2016 and nine months period ended 31" December, 2016 are based on the previously issued standalone financial results that were reviewed by the erstwhile auditors (vide their unmodified limited review report dated 02.02.2017).

This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on

- 2 The limited review for the quarter ended on 31st December, 2017, as required under Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing obligation & disclosure requirements) Regulation, 2015 has been carried out by the Statutory Auditors. The financial results relating to quarter ended 31st December, 2016 under Ind AS have not been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company. However, the mangement has exercised due diligence to ensure that the financial results provide true and fair view of the
- 3 The Company has adopted Indian Accounting Standards ("IND AS") with effect from 1 April, 2017 and consequently, these financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in 'IND AS 34-Interim Financial Reporting' prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. The date of transition to Ind AS is 1 April, 2016 and the impact of transition has been accounted for in opening reserves and the comparative period results disclosed here are restated accordingly. However, the opening balance sheet as at 1 April, 2016 and the results of the subsequent periods would get finalised alongwith the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 March, 2018.

There is a possibility that these quarterly financial results alongwith the opening balance sheet as of 1 April, 2016 and provisional financial statements as of and for the year ended March 31, 2017 may require adjustment before constituting the final Ind AS financial statements as of and for the year ending March 31, 2018 due to changes in financial reporting requirements arising from new or revised standards or interpretations issued by MCA or changes in the use of one or more optional exemptions from full retrospective application of certain Ind AS as permitted under Ind AS 101.

- As per exemption given in para 2.6.1 (iii) of the SEBI Circular No.CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 05.07.2016, the Ind AS compliant financial results for the previous year ended 31st March, 2017 have not been provided.
- Goods and Service Tax ("GST") has been implemented with effect from 1st July 2017and therefore, revenue from operations for the quarter ended 30th September, 2017 and 31st December, 2017 are net of GST. Revenue from operations and expenses for the quarter and nine months ended 31st December, 2016 being inclusive of excise duty are not comparable with corresponding figures of quarter and nine months ended 31st Decmeber, 2017.
